Standard Operating Guideline

Apparatus Responding Order

A) For all fire related calls the following should be sent: Engine 2 or Engine 6, Tanker 5, and Rescue 3 if personnel is available. The Incident Commander will decide if any other equipment is required or other agencies are needed. For example the Power Corp., Mutual Aid.

B) For all Motor Vehicle Collisions the following should be sent: Engine 2 or Engine 6, Rescue 3, and Utility 4 if personnel is available. The Incident Commander will decide if any other equipment is required or other agencies are needed. For example the Power Corp., Mutual Aid.

C) For all, water and nature rescues, the Special Operations Trailer will be towed by Engine 6, Back-up may be provided by Utility 4 and / or Rescue 3 depending on the Incident Commanders orders. ATC 12 will be towed by Utility 7.

D) For all Medical Emergencies the following should be sent: Utility 4 and Utility 7, if in the Scott's Bay area. Incident Command will decide if any other equipment is required or other agencies are needed. For example the Power Corp. or Mutual Aid. In the case of a Cardiac Arrest call the Utility 4 may respond with as few as two members. These two members have to be trained in the use of the defibrillator. Back up will be provided by Rescue 3. The crew of Rescue #3 will take their turnout gear with them.

E) For all stand-in calls to other Fire Department Stations the units will respond Code 2 (no emergency lights or siren). For Mutual Aid calls going to the scene of a call the unit will respond back up may be provided by Utility 7 and/or Rescue 3. ATC 12 will be towed by Utility 7.
