Standard Operating Guideline

Defibrillator Equipment

A) In Station 1 one defib is to be stored on the wall. The crew of Rescue 3 is to look after the maintenance of the defib on the wall. The defib, supplied by EHS, shall be kept in Engine #2 and the crew of Engine #2 will look after the maintenance.

B) In Station 2 the defib is to be stored in Utility 7. The crew of Utility 7 is to look after the maintenance of the defib.

C) The defibs can be taken in any vehicle if need to be. Generally it responds in the first vehicle that is dispatched to a medical emergency call.

D) When Station 2's Utility 7 leaves the station, they only leave the defib behind if there is a defib-trained member available to operate it in an emergency situation. Otherwise the defib travels with the unit.

E) If Utility 7 is taken out of service, the defib is to be placed in Engine #1. When Utility 7 is placed back in service, the defib is put back in the unit
