Standard Operating Guideline

Mutual Aid

- A) All vehicles, equipment and personnel will be made available for Mutual Aid purposes as prescribed by the Kings County Chiefs Working Group.

- B) All Vehicles, equipment, and personnel sent outside of the Canning Fire Department District for Mutual Aid will come under the direct command of the Senior Officer or Incident Commander of the Calling Fire Department and will be released by said Fire Department.

- C) At no time as a result of Mutual Aid will the Canning Fire Department District be left unprotected. At least one unit will remain in the Village at all times unless the Incident Commander or a Senior Officer finds it necessary to move all equipment to the scene of the emergency and standby from another Department is made available.

- D) The Canning Volunteer Fire Department does not expect all Mutual Aid stand-in crews to be trained in everything. The stand-in crews are to respond to all calls to the best of their abilities, and not do any activity above their level of training.(Example Medical Calls)
